Telemedicine, or telehealth, has many advantages, including **Convenience**, **Cost Savings**, and **Access to Care**.

Cost savings: Avoid travel costs: You don't need to pay for gas, public transportation, or parking

My experience with Telemedicine: During the "covid pandemic" (2021) my wife had an irritation in her eye that she was able to get examined over a secure camera connection by a Medical Doctor. Remember this was a time when you could not get an appointment in a Doctor's Office. She was diagnosed and received a prescription for anti bacterial eye drops which was sent directly to a pharmacy.

Recently (2025) I had a cough that would not stop and over the counter cough medicine was not effective. I was examined over the phone by a Telemedicine Doctor who sent a Prescription Cough Medicine to a local pharmacy. This medicine was effective at suppressing the cough and I was able to sleep and heal.
