

# Disability Stat Pack

These numbers show why every working American needs paycheck protection.



More than **1 in 4** of today's 20 year olds will experience disability before reaching full retirement age.<sup>1</sup>



**7.789 million** disabled workers receive Social Security benefits, as of June 2022.<sup>2</sup>



The average monthly SSDI benefit is only **\$1,361.88.**<sup>2</sup>



Many people lack savings – even high-income earners. Nearly **40%** of people earning more than **\$100,000** live paycheck to paycheck.<sup>3</sup>



Americans are falling behind. Among people with personal savings, the average amount dropped from **\$73K** in 2021 to just **\$62K** in 2022.<sup>4</sup>



Even with health insurance, medical bills can add up. Approximately **23 million** americans owe medical debt.<sup>5</sup>



Many different conditions can cause **long-term** disability claims.<sup>6</sup>



Musculoskeletal Disorders – **27.6%**



Cancer – **15%**



Injuries – **12%**



Mental Health – **9.3%**



Circulatory Issues – **8.2%**
